As we have had to adapt and respond to an international pandemic and introduce new ways of teaching and learning, our way of life has also changed. The Welsh Government has issued guidance for returning to school in January:

- **Monday 04.01.21, Tuesday 05.01.21** - planning days. No school for learners
- **Wednesday 06.01.21, Thursday 07.01.21, Friday 08.01.21** - distance learning for all
- **Wednesday 06.01.21** - the school will invite vulnerable learners to attend
- **Monday 11.01.21** - we will begin to welcome back our year groups to school. These arrangements will be confirmed on Monday 04.01.21 and communicated with you before the end of that day.

## Year 10, 11, 12 and 13 Learners

Following the Government announcement today we will delay the internal assessments to coincide with the national assessment window. Learners will therefore receive a timetable of internal assessments upon their return to school, once the WJEC has shared further guidance with schools early in the new year. These internal assessments will be conducted under controlled conditions in classrooms between March 22nd and April 23rd.
