Dear Parent / Guardian,

At the end of a very busy half term, we would like to take the opportunity to thank you once again for your continued support and cooperation.

We also ask for your support with the following as we welcome the learners back to school following the half term break.

School uniform

The school has high expectations for all our learners which includes the school uniform. Every learner is expected to meet our standards in order to celebrate the school's identity and ethos. We remind you of the school uniform policy (details can be found at <https://www.yggllangynwyd.cymru/gwisg-ysgol/>).

- **No jewellery at all for KS3 and 4 learners which includes piercings of any kind. Any jewellery worn by learners will be taken to the main office in an envelope to be collected at the end of the day. One pair of earrings (studs) are permitted for KS5 learners.**
- **No makeup (including false nails / acrylics)**
- **Natural hair colours and sensible styles**
- **No tight trousers or leggings**
- **Appropriate length for skirts (to the knee)**
- **Leather shoes (no trainers / boots)**
- **Dark coats without logos**

In rare occasions where learners do not meet these uniform standards the Head of Year will be in contact in order to resolve the issue. Learners will work in Llannerch until this conversation has taken place.

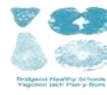
Physical Education Kit

On days where learners have a PE lesson, they must continue to come to school in the official PE uniform. Only school hoodies are permitted. We ask that they also bring their school uniform in order to change if there are poor weather conditions. We will be monitoring the situation periodically next half term to see if individuals are taking advantage of the situation and wearing the PE kit on days where they don't have a PE lesson.
