Captain Elis Bird managed to pull the strings from the outside half position, coordinating an excellent backline move in the Porthcawl half to release Leo Quinn in space who avoided the defenders and crossed the whitewash for a top-class try.

The Llan boys finished the 1st half on a positive note with our dangerous and agile centre Connor Jones striding through the defensive line to score a memorable solo try. Score at half 15-14 to Llangynwyd.

The second half proved to be a difficult one with the boys playing up the slope and suffering some injuries that disrupted the flow of our play. However, the spirit, effort and dedication of all players throughout this period must be commended. Their perseverance was evident, especially with continued fierce defensive work by Jack Martin, Jackson Treloar and Gruff Owen up until the final minutes. The highlight of the second half for Llangynwyd was Leo Quinn's stunning solo try from his own half to beat the opposing defenders with speed to score untouched in the corner.

Despite the loss, it was a privilege to be able to provide the boys with the opportunity to represent the school rugby team once again for the 1st time in over 18 months. Plenty to build upon, especially with players returning to the squad following absences today.
